# WINTERFEST 2010 FEBRUARY 26<sup>TH</sup> & 27<sup>TH</sup>

## COMMUNITY CHALLENGE – THE DETAILS

1. Teams must consist of 8 - 10 members (Age regulations are event specific, please refer to individual event rules). Small businesses are encouraged to band together to form teams, sport teams, community groups, families, friends, and not-for-profit agencies are all encouraged to enter the challenge!! You may register 3 alternates as long as everyone has signed the release forms and payment for the 10 people has been received.
2. Individuals may register by themselves and the **WINTERFEST** Committee will put these people together at random to make teams, or will link them with teams who are having difficulty getting enough team members. You must do so by the early bird deadline.
3. **Mystery Events are back!** It is in teams' best interest to have members with a variety of skills for this year's challenge because we have 1 event that is classified as MYSTERY EVENTS and will not be revealed until the day of the event.
4. Each team must have a designated Team Leader to serve as a communications officer and liaison between the **WINTERFEST** planning squad and team members. Team Leaders will be responsible for ensuring their teams are on time, informed of the rules for each event and fully prepared to participate.
5. **Early Bird registration deadline Friday February 5<sup>th</sup>.** The registration deadline is Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 5:00 PM, full payment must be received at this time as well. The Early Bird registration fee for corporate and small business teams is \$15/team member, after February 5<sup>th</sup> the fee is \$20/team member. Early bird registration fee for not-for-profit groups, organizations and/or families is \$10/team member, after February 6<sup>th</sup> the fee is \$15/team member. We will accept paid registrations on a first come, first serve basis to a maximum of 12 teams.
6. There will be a one hour Team Captains meeting on Wednesday, February 24<sup>th</sup> 7:00 PM, AT THE TOWN HALL. All Team Leaders are requested to be in attendance.
7. Please refer to individual event rules to determine what equipment competitors are responsible for and what the **WINTERFEST** organizing committee will provide. In some cases advanced preparation may be required to build equipment or for team practice.
8. This is a FUN, RECREATIONAL and dry community event. We would like to emphasize the importance of fair play and sportsmanship. There will be an overall champion awarded for the team with the most points, and MANY fun prizes for various different "achievements" throughout the day!
9. The point system will vary depending on amount of teams entered. 2 points between each of the top three placings then 1 point less for each placing after that. Every team that completes an event will get at least 1 point. i.e for 7 teams registered:
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> place finish/event = 10 pts
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish/event = 8 pts
  - c. 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish/event = 6 pts
  - d. 4<sup>th</sup> place finish/event = 4 pts
  - e. 5<sup>th</sup> place finish/event = 3 pts
  - f. 6<sup>th</sup> place finish/event = 2 pt
  - g. 7<sup>th</sup> place finish/event = 1 pt
10. There will also be 5 bonus points for one volunteer that your team supplies for the event, as well as 5 bonus point for registering before the early bird registration date.

5. All Fired Up Relay (8-10 team members)(some members need to be over 18)
6. Scavenger Hunt WinterFest Style (whole team)(Will need a digital camera for this event- if no access to one let Committee know and we will make arrangements)
7. Snow Sculpture (8 – 10 participants)(Team is responsible for bringing non motorized equipment to build sculpture and non toxic coloring agents)
8. Shmoosharama Relay (7-10 people)
9. Sneaky Snowman Hockey Shoot (whole Team 8-10 people everyone needs clean runners)
10. Crazy Curling (whole team- everyone needs a clean pair of runners)
11. Up Down all Around Relay(8 members)
