November 2020 the calls had a significant decrease over last month with 153 total calls for service within the Town of High Level.

There were 8 reported assaults, 1 report of Aggravated Assault, Charges have been laid on 4 of those files, 2 were unfounded, and 2 resolved by complainant/victim wishing no action.

There were 2 break and enter files reported in November, 1 resulting in charges and the other had insufficient evidence to proceed.

There were 3 impaired driving complaints. Resulting in charges in 1 incident.

There were 12 Liquor Act related incidents with no charges laid officer discretion was used and the subject of complaint were lodged until they were sober and able to care for themselves.

There were 27 calls for mischief to property or obstruction of enjoyment of property which were all cleared using discretion.

There were 3 mental health calls, 1 was unfounded and the other 2 files the persons were dealt via the hospital.

There were 4 reports of missing persons, all of which were located.

There were NO Sexual Assault files for the month of November.

There were 11- 911 calls, 5 of them were unfounded, and 2 were actual calls for service.

There were 3 reports of stolen vehicles all of which are still under investigation.

There were 4 reports of utter threats, 2 were cleared by discretion and 2 were unfounded.

There were 20 allegations of failing to comply with Judicial orders which resulted in 18 charge files and 2 were dealt with by way of discretion.

Other files included assistance to other agencies, accidents, and general assistance to the public.

The new Sergeant OPS NCO has been identified and it is Mike Burns who is currently on the Historical Homicide Unit in Whitehorse. He should be here early in the New Year.

### Criminal Code Offences



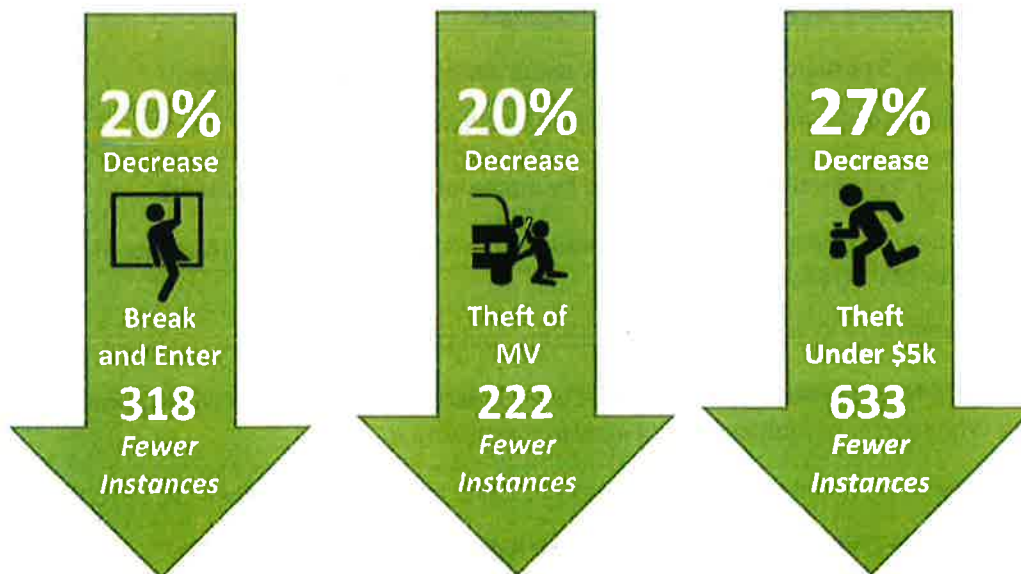
