July 2020 the calls had a decrease over last month with 337 total calls for service within the Town of High Level.

There were 11 reported assaults, 4 Assault with a weapon / causing bodily harm, 1 Assault Police Officer file. Charges have been laid on 7 of those files, 2 were unfounded.

There were 0 break and enter files reported in July.

There were 3 impaired driving complaints. Resulting in charges in 2 incidents and the 3rd was unfounded

There were 26 Liquor Act related incidents. 7 resulted in charges being laid, the other 18 were lodged until they were sober and able to care for themselves.

There were 63 calls for mischief to property or obstruction of enjoyment of property which were cleared using discretion.

There were 10 mental health calls, the persons were dealt via the hospital.

There was a complaint that resulted in charges for carry a concealed weapon.

1 Report of forcible confinement that resulted in charges.

There were 2 Sexual Assault files, charges have been laid on 1 file and the other is still under investigation.

There were 4 vehicles reported stolen, charges have also been laid on 2 of these files and only 1 vehicle outstanding

There were 911 calls, 15 of them were unfounded, 1 were either unable to be found or children were involved.

Other files included assistance to other agencies, accidents, and general assistance to the public.

Sergeant. Position was posted and closed July 29th. Cpl. Barber was in acting Sergeant Position.

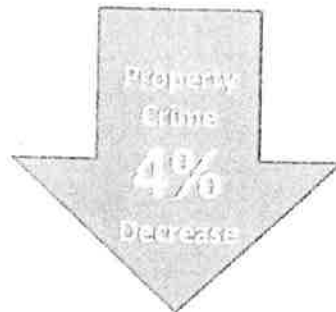
